

# Wiltshire Sight Lotto

## Rules



Membership is open to all. Those administering the draw will not participate. There is a lower age limit of 18 years.

Wiltshire Sight Lotto will operate with an expected minimum of 100 members.

There is no limit on the quantity of numbers permitted, additional numbers may be purchased at any time.

Numbers will be allocated numerically to individuals.

Members may join at any time. There is a 12 month minimum period of involvement.

Purchase is by standing order or cheque only to be paid at the start of each year.

Each number costs £2.00 per month, resulting in a payment of £24.00 per year per number. Members will retain the same number/s for the duration of their involvement.

The draw will take place on the last Friday of every month (wherever possible) including holiday periods. It will be made by a member of staff at Wiltshire Sight in the company of at least one other, who is not connected to the administration of Wiltshire Sight Lotto; their decision is final.

Prize money will be presented in the form of a cheque (or by other means by arrangement). The prize will be 25% of the money raised through Wiltshire Sight Lotto.

Results will be published on the website in the week following the draw; the winner will also be notified by email or by phone and the winning number will also be published in the Newsletter
